- Re: Safe Access for Recreation Center Party Halls effective January 2022

Effective December 1, 2021, Honolulu Mayor Rick Blangiardi announced that the capacity restrictions for large events have been lifted.

Along with operating at full capacity, these events will be allowed to serve food and drinks in compliance with the **Safe Access Oahu Program**.

## Safe Access Oahu Program:

- Provide proof of \*full vaccination
  - Hard copy of state approved vaccination card
  - Photo of state approved vaccination card
  - A Hawaii state-approved digital/smart device application confirming full vaccination status

## - OR -

- Negative COVID-19 test within 48 hours
  - A negative or "not detected" test result must be a U.S. Food and Drug Administration emergency use authorization, or approved molecular test, or antigen test taken within 48 hours
  - At-home COVID 19 test will not be accepted

**MUST INCLUDE A PICTURE ID FOR VERIFICATION** (Drivers License, State ID, Military ID, School ID, Work ID or Passport with picture and name)

\*"full vaccination" means two weeks have passed after the second dose in a two-dose COVID-19 vaccination series or two weeks have passed after a single-dose regardless of whether a COVID-19 booster has been received.

- Children 11 years old and under are EXEMPT

- Masks must be worn (except when eating or drinking)

An MTA employee will be checking for proof of vaccination or negative test results prior to entrance. A wrist band will be provided.

We ask that a member of the party be assigned to assist MTA employee with checking in and passing out wrist bands.

Renter on the contract is responsible for all guests: checking for wristbands and ensuring masks are being worn (except for when eating or drinking).
